He has also served as President of the Indo-Pacific Federation of the Society. At present Pedro is the Education Coordinator of the TS in Australia. He has lectured widely for the Society in Australia and in many countries and his articles have appeared in a number of TS journals. He is the author of the book *N. Sri Ram – A Life of Beneficence and Wisdom* published by TPH Adyar in 2009.
